

Subject: Fair Exhibit Entry Deadline Fast Approaching

The deadline for entering your exhibits in this year's Plumas Sierra County Fair is fast approaching. July 14 is the last day to get your entry forms to the Fair Office or postmarked before being charged a late fee. "It is quite a job to enter all the entries into our Blue Ribbon software," reports Office Manager Kathy Tedford, "we need that time to make sure all our information is accurate."

Tedford wanted to remind everyone that the deadline was for entry forms only, exhibitors still have until August to actually deliver their jams, needlework, paintings, flowers, collections, photographs or baked goods to the fairgrounds. There are hundreds of categories to enter. The fair is the opportunity for residents to show off what they have made, raised or grown. Copies of the exhibit guide are available at local libraries, banks or the Fair Office. You can also download a copy from the Fair website; www.plumas-sierracountyfair.net.

Once again, to make it easier to enter, the Fair has arranged for pick up days in all the outlying areas on July 31, 9am to noon. Volunteers have stepped up to man locations and accept entries from local residents. They will then transport the entries to the Fair for competition and then bring them back for pick up in each community the following Saturday, August 21, 9am to noon.

Loyalton pick up and drop off will be at the Loyalton Elementary School multi purpose room, Portola will be at the Methodist Church Social Hall, Indian Valley will be at the Taylorsville Mineral Building and Chester will be in the High School Parking lot.
