

Subject: Trailer Choir releases debut CD

Show Dog-Universal Music recording artists Trailer Choir performed on the 2010 CMT Music Awards, June 9. They premiered their newly released single “Shakin’ That Tailgate” from their debut CD, *Tailgate*. The CD will be released July 6, 2010.

Trailer Choir will be performing at the Plumas Sierra County Fair on Friday, August 13. It marks the return of a national act to the fairgrounds that have hosted the likes of Reba McEntire, Johnny Cash, Alabama and Merle Haggard.

Tailgate is the highly anticipated debut CD from the band who released the biggest summer song of 2009, “Rockin’ the Beer Gut,” a single that has already sold a quarter of a million copies. That song, along with the latest single from the CD, “Rollin’ Through the Sunshine,” will be included on *Tailgate*. Trailer Choir has been touring throughout California this year after opening for Toby Keith in 2009.

“We are very excited to have a performer of this caliber at the Fair.” Says Fair Manager John Steffanic, “Our fingers are crossed that their new CD and singles hit the charts hard and fast!” Ticket sales are already going well reports Steffanic, but if “Shakin’ That Tailgate” climbs the charts, tickets will get snapped up fast.
